
SECTION-I | Using the Recording Pack

The Recording pack is an optional accessory that allows the user's voice along with the music to be stored on a chip. The Recording pack is physically the same with a Song chip, but the type of data stored in these are different. And unlike a Song chip, the Recording pack is reprogrammable.


- 1.** *Turn off the ED8000. Insert the recording pack in one of the four slots inside the microphone. The recording pack can be inserted alongside other Song chips.*
- 2.** *Turn on the ED8000, select the song you would like to record.*
- 3.** *Press MODE + REC. The song will automatically play and the user's voice along with the instrumentals will both be recorded.*
- 4.** *The user may stop the recording before the song ends by pressing PLAY/STOP. After the recording is made, you can play your recording by pressing REC.*
- 5.** *A list of recorded songs will be displayed on the TV screen.*
- 6.** *In case there are many songs, press UP / DOWN to scroll through the list.*
- 7.** *Press PLAY/STOP to play the recording.*
(Note : The vocals are temporarily disabled during recording playback, thus the user can not sing during playback.)
- 8.** *Press PLAY/STOP again to stop the playback.*

SECTION-II | How to Install the Download Manager

1. Insert the Data CD and copy the folder *Installer* to your hardisk.
2. Open the folder *Installer* on your hardisk
3. Double click the *Download Manager* icon.
4. The window below will appear. Select the language you wish to install and click *Next*.




5. The window below will appear. Click *Next*.



6. The window below will appear. Click Install.




7. The window below will appear. Click Finish.




SECTION-III | How to Install the USB Driver

1. Double click the USB Driver icon.

2. The window below will appear. Select the language you wish to install and click Ok.



3. The window below will appear. Click Next.




SECTION-III | How to Install the USB Driver

B. Company Name




3. The window below will appear. Click Next.

6. *The installation is complete, you need to restart your computer before using the Download Software. Click Finish.*



SECTION-IV | Using the Download Manager

1. Insert the Recording Pack to the ED-8000.

(Note : Make sure the unit is turned off.)

2. Connect the 7 pin cable, adaptor, and USB cable to the ED-8000.

3. Connect the other terminal of the USB cable to the USB port on the computer.


4. Turn on the ED-8000.

The first time that the ED-8000 is connected to the computer, the following windows below will appear one after the other,

A. Select Yes, this time only and click Next




B. Select Install the software automatically, and click Next



A. Select Yes, this time only and click Next




B. Select Install the software automatically, and click Next



5. Double click the USB Download Manager Icon
(Located by default in the PC's desktop) to start the USB Download Manager.

6. At the tool bar, press **LIST** button to show the list of songs recorded on the Recording pack.

7. Select a recording on the Recording pack and press **READ** to download it to the computer.

Note: The Song code is used as reference to a recording, therefore

The user must always make sure that the same song chip used during the recording is also on the microphone during playback or download.

The recording will be downloaded as ".etw" file. ".etw" is a proprietary format that can only be processed by the ET USB DOWNLOAD MANAGER.

8. Select a downloaded recording ("etw" file) on the computer and press **PLAY** to play it.

SECTION-IV | Using the Download Manager

9. You can also convert a downloaded file ("etw" file) to wave format (.wav) in order for other softwares (such as Windows Media player) to play it. Simply press **CONVERT**.

Note : When converted, wave files are much larger than their original ".etw" files (about 10 times larger). The converted files (wave files) can not be reconverted back to original ".etw" files.

10. You can upload a previously downloaded recording ".etw" to another recording pack. Simply select a downloaded recording ("etw" file) and press **WRITE**.

11. You can also delete a song on a recording pack. Simply select the recording and press **DELETE**.

12. To close the Download Manager, press **EXIT**.

DOWNLOAD MANAGER QUICK GUIDE

WRITE	Select the song on the computer and press WRITE to upload the song from the PC to the recording pack.
READ	Select the song on the recording pack and press READ to download the song to the computer.
LIST	Click LIST to show the recorded songs on the recording pack.
DELETE	Select the song on the recording pack and press DELETE to remove it.
EXIT	Click EXIT to close the download manager.
PLAY	Select the song on the computer and press PLAY to hear the recording.
STOP	Press STOP to halt it.
CONVERT	Select a downloaded song and press CONVERT to create its equivalent wave file
